## Job Description/Duties/Requirements/Work Environment – Cellar Person

### DESCRIPTION

This position reports directly to Jarid Truppo, Head Brewer of East Coast Beer Co. LLC. The cellar assistant position is responsible for assisting the Head Brewer and other brewery staff in some aspects of cellar work. This includes cleaning, transferring, and packaging of product as specified by Beach Haus® Brewery's Standard Operating Procedure.

### JOB DUTIES

- Ability to perform all cellar operations:
- Startup and shutdown of facility processes
- Assisting on brew days
- Kegging and canning beer
- Cleaning and sanitizing of equipment and lines
- Transferring product from fermenter to brite
- Monitoring of quality parameters and working to resolve issues promptly
- Accurate daily record keeping
- Maintain an orderly and safe work environment in department as well as entire facility
- Take direction from Brewery Management and Head Brewer
- Contributing to positive work environment through open and constructive dialog
- Contribute and be receptive to continual innovation and improvements
- Communicate issues and concerns as they arise with staff and management

### REQUIREMENTS/EXPERIENCE/SKILLS

- MUST BE 21 years of age and have a valid NJ driver's license
- Ability to work varied shifts -- including weekends
- Knowledge of industrial controls and instrumentation a plus
- Strong orientation towards quality control and safety
- Mechanical aptitude
- Ability to multitask and adjust to changing priorities while focusing on detail
- Good time management skills
